DESCRIPTION

7a. Architectural style: Prairie with Neo-Georgian overtones

7b. Briefly describe the present physical description of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This two story symmetrical stucco house is roofed with asphalt tile and is trimmed with painted wood. The roof is truncated and has projecting eaves. Stucco chimneys give balance at each side. A concrete stoop implies a concrete foundation. The windows are rectangular, some in arcades and some fixed with mullions at the top. There are narrow moldings and a shelf on the front windows. The centered doorway is indented. There is a solid wood door with a beveled glass window in a geometric shape. One half Doric columns trim the doorway. There are long paned windows flanking the door opening. An open portico with square pillars of stucco on rough cut granite is an important feature to this house and show a Palladian influence. A railing around the top of the portico forms a balcony with French doors giving access to the house. A flat roofed one story extension on one side has a doorway and stoop. The house and yard are in good condition.


