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

## DESCRIPTION

- 7a. Architectural style: Neo-Colonial/Neo-Classical with Queen Anne overtones
- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical description* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

Front and side facing gables and multi-gabled roof lines are strong features of this structure. A slanted bay window across the front with rich ornamentation in base relief is applied above windows. Similiar ornamentation is on the porch frieze. A gable front has shingle decoration in varied patterns. A small dormer window has three panels and forms a tiny bay. Ionic columns support the front porch and is recessed to one side. Diamond shaped mullions and double panel windows on the porch, with molded trim surround the doors. There is a transom over the doors. There are mullioned windows in slanted bays on both sides of the house. An additional entry door is on the side with a 6-light window in top half of the solid door. This door also has a transom.
